Supplemental Services under NCLB

According to No Child Left Behind guidelines, parents that have made the choice to have their students remain in their home school, which has been on program improvement for more that two consecutive years, may have access to supplemental Services. Supplemental services are extended educational opportunities in math, reading and language arts. These services are available to students attending a school that has been in program improvement for more that two consecutive years. Priority for these services is based on economic disadvantage, academic need, and availability of Title I set-aside funds.

Supplemental services are provided from educational groups outside of the school program. They may provide these extended learning opportunities before or after school. These providers will regularly inform the parent and the teacher of the student's progress. Access to these services may be provided until the funding limit for that child is reached.

Supplemental service providers are approved through an application process set by the State Office of Education for the state of Utah. This list of providers can be accessed through the State Office of Education's web site, through the district office, or through the office of your home school. Parents have the choice to select the provider they would like their child to participate with. Providers have the option of not providing services to select geographic areas.

Application forms for supplemental service are made through the office of your home school or on this website. Applications must be returned to your home school office. The application will be processed by that school to determine eligibility for supplemental services.
